



Marine Exchange of Alaska Membership

Marine Exchange of Alaska's (MXAK) initiatives, services and programs are funded by membership dues, fees for vessel tracking, consulting services provided and government grants. MXAK's maritime advocacy efforts are directed towards minimizing the cost of complying with regulatory requirements while aiding safe, secure, efficient and environmentally responsible maritime operations. Our 7 day, 24 hour Operations Center, informational web site, newsletters, vessel tracking network and access are also partially funded by membership dues. Presently membership is comprised of almost all segments of the Alaska maritime community including ports, pilot organizations and various waterfront facilities, as well as operators of tugs and barges, cruise ships, passenger vessels, offshore supply vessels, fishing vessels, tankers and container ships.

Membership Levels

General Membership: This \$1,000 a year membership level applies to operators of vessels and facilities that directly benefit from MXAK's services and advocacy efforts. General Members are entitled to free technical advice in complying with Coast Guard, State and DOT safety, hazardous material, environmental and security regulations as well as reduced rates for the conduct of audits, preparation of security, safety and environmental plans, and other assistance. Members are also entitled to free access to the Marine Exchange's basic vessel tracking display, PacTracs Lite and reduced rates for the full featured vessel tracking system, PacTracs.

Associate Membership: This \$500 a year membership annual membership applies to maritime services providers that benefit from MXAK's maritime network and services. Associate Members are listed on the Marine Exchange web site and entitled to free limited access to MXAK's basic vessel tracking display, PacTracs Lite.
