Greetings from the Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) Outreach Team,

Enrollment for the TWIC program in Alaska has begun. There will be multiple locations throughout the state of Alaska where stakeholders can enroll in the program.

- Fixed Site locations: *Juneau, Anchorage, Nikiski and Valdez.*
- Mobile Enrollment locations will be available in the following locations for a limited time: *Kodiak, Cordova, Dutch Harbor, Petersburg, Wrangell, Craig, Ketchikan, Sitka, Skagway, and Haines.*

From the home page, you can click on the gray Schedule button in the top right-hand portion of the screen. Once you are on the Schedule page, enter in any of the TWIC enrollment center locations. This is where you can go to get the most up to date information on opening/closing dates, addresses and hours of operation. Please keep in mind that whichever site you enroll at, you will need to return to the same location at a later date to activate your card. For the mobile locations, there will be a limited time where they will reopen to conduct card activation. Stakeholders that enroll at a mobile site will be notified when this will occur so that proper preparations can be made.
